

## **Chili Cook-Off Rules and Information**

- 1) Teams shall consist of 1-4 persons with an entry fee of <u>\$50</u> to be paid prior to the registration deadline on January 30, 2017.
- 2) Your team may begin setup at 9am and must be ready for general public sampling by 11:00am.
- Chili can be precooked or cooked on location. However, there will be no access to a kitchen. You
  must provide your own warming devices. You will have access to an electrical outlet. Please bring
  an extension cord and/or power strip.
- 4) Each team will be provided a space with an uncovered 6'x 2 1/2' table. Sampling cups, spoons and napkins will be provided.
- 5) Please provide enough chili to serve to the general public, a minimum of 5 gallons is required.
- 6) All teams are encouraged to create a theme that is presented throughout all elements of your team (i.e. team name, dress, decoration of space, etc.) A prize will be awarded for best team theme.
- 7) Judging will take place at 12:00pm. Awards will be announced and presented at 1:00pm. Chili will be judged based on appearance, aroma and taste.
- 8) No beverages can be brought into Tan-Tar-A. A cash bar will be available.
